Dear Mr. Reynolds:

I never received your letter to me dated September 30, 2021, which appears to have been sent to an incorrect address for the Georgia Republican Party. I did, however, have an opportunity to read it yesterday in The Atlanta Journal Constitution.

Your letter seems to suggest that the only information we drew to your attention was the GPS tracking data showing 279 mobile devices which came into repeated contact with absentee ballot drop box locations in six counties of Metro Atlanta. It omits much of the information that we shared which places that data in the context of our concern that tens of thousands of absentee ballots or more were illegally "harvested" and deposited into the absentee ballot drop boxes.

As one example of the information that we shared, during Columbus Day weekend before the 2020 General Election, a single drop box received 1,962 ballots during a time period when only 24 mobile devices came within 100 feet of the drop box. An innocent explanation for this anomaly is that 1,938 voters parked their automobiles more than 100 feet from the drop box, left their mobile devices in their automobile, and walked their 1,962 ballots, one by one, to the drop box. A less innocent explanation is that one or more individuals illegally dumped nearly 1,962 ballots in the drop box. Pointing to the likelihood of the less innocent explanation is that two of the 24 mobile devices coming within 100 feet of the drop box were on the list of 279 suspicious (or using your word, "curious") devices.

Other examples of suspicious ("curious") information drawn to your attention include the unexplained disappearance of legally mandated surveillance video, including the video of the Columbus Day drop box, video showing the same individual visiting more than one drop box, video showing individuals bringing ballots to drop boxes in book bags and individuals carrying ballots to drop boxes wearing disposable surgical gloves. I am not going to use this letter to recount every detail of our discussions over the last six months, but suffice it say, I believe the information provided or offered to you cries out for investigation.
